What do you hunger for ?

This Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi - we celebrate the great gift we have of the real presence of the Body and Blood of Christ which we receive in Eucharist.

There's a great American saying I heard once, 'You can pretend to care, but you can't pretend to be there'. Our God is here, fully present, fully engaged in our lives. Our God would bless and transform all things, bringing everything into perfect union with God: into the Kingdom of God. When we see what God has done in Jesus, we know this is true and accomplished - but when we see suffering and despair in the world, we know that we have to work with God to bring healing and hope - the Kingdom of God - to the whole world.

We are called - as a Eucharistic people - to be the Body of Christ in our local place, to be Christ's hands and feet in our community. So we walk in our streets this weekend not to show off, but to humbly recommit ourselves to this task. 'Look' we say, 'not at us, but at God who will not desert you'. 'Look' we invite, 'not at our faith but at Gods love'. This is our Christ: Fully present, Fully committed to us. This is our Lord who says 'this is my body given for you'. We are a pilgrim people, hungry for the whole world to know what we do - that the God of love has never left us alone, and walks with us still. **Alleluia.**
