Holy Week: The Mother of all Vigils.

During Holy Week the Church celebrates the mysteries of Salvation accomplished by Christ by the last days of his life on earth beginning with his entrance into Jerusalem. Please take home the Blessed Palm with you.

Holy Thursday. The Mass of the Last Supper is celebrated in the evening Crecora 7 p.m. Raheen 8 p.m., when the full participation of the whole local community should be present. The washing of the feet should be explained. Gifts for the poor (Trócaire) may be presented in the procession of the gifts. The commitment of the Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist should be made.

Good Friday: Celebration of the Lord's Passion, Veneration of the Cross, and the Distribution of Holy Communion takes place at 3 p.m. when Christians are united throughout the world celebrating Christ' death on the Cross of Calvary. Good Friday is the day of Fast and Abstinence observed in the whole church. The Stations of the Cross will be held at evening time Raheen 7.30 p.m. Crecora 8 p.m.to facilitate those who cannot attend the celebration of the Lord's Passion.

Holy Saturday: The Church awaits the Resurrection of Jesus in silence. The Easter Vigil is celebrated at 9 p.m. The full meaning of the Resurrection of Christ from the dead is revealed in the celebration of the Easter Vigil. The Paschal Candle, the Exsultet (The great Easter Hymn of Praise) Celebration of the Word of God and the Renewal of our Baptismal promises are an explicit part of the Liturgy of Easter. The celebration of the Eucharist is the commemoration of the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross and the presence of the Risen Christ in our midst (The source and summit of our Christian life). May each of you have a very Happy Easter. Don't forget to take home the Easter Water and we look forward to your participation in the most important Feast of the year – Easter.
