

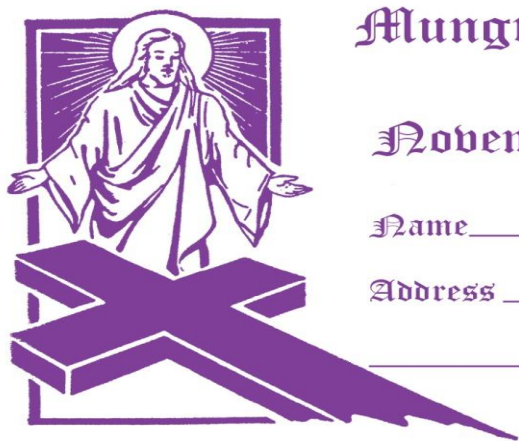

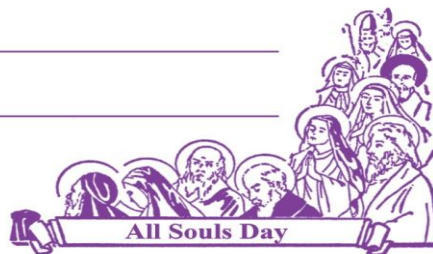

**University Maternity Hospital Limerick** holds its Annual Remembrance  
Service at the **Holy Rosary Church, Ennis Road, Limk. Sunday, Nov. 5th (3pm).**  
We invite parents who have experienced the death of their baby/pregnancy loss at  
any stage, together with their family, friends and hospital staff to this service.  
This service is organised by the Counselling Department and Midwifery staff at  
UMHL. And people are very welcome to stay after the service for a chat and a  
cup of tea. To ensure sensitivity towards newly bereaved families, a quiet space  
will be available at the church for crying babies/young children. The service is  
an annual event which aims to acknowledge the pregnancies that were lost and  
the lives of babies who have died through ectopic pregnancy, miscarriage,  
stillbirth and neonatal death. We welcome parents and families whose babies  
may have died many years ago as well as those more recently bereaved.

**Desert Day:** You are invited to a quiet peaceful day away from your busy  
schedule to remember your departed loved ones. The day will consist of quiet  
prayer, reflection and will conclude with the Eucharist. Venue: Westbourne,

**Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of 'All Souls':** From 12 noon  
on 1st November until mid-night on the 2nd November all who have confessed,  
received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our  
Father and a Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary  
indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and  
the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the  
departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the  
week following 1st of November. Holy Communion maybe received on any day  
from 1st of November to the 8th of November. For every other visit made to a  
church during this time, a partial indulgence for the same intention made be  
gained. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a  
plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions  
once per day from the 1st to the 8th of November. The conditions mentioned  
above apply also for this.
