

Ciara Micks (16) from Raheen saw her world demolished three years ago when she developed Ehlers Danlos Syndrome (EDS). EDS affects joints, connective tissue and vital organs and within six weeks of diagnosis, Ciara went from being an active teenager, swimming and dancing to being unable to walk. Now she is almost bedridden, needs an oxygen tank and, because of



the instability of her neck and skull, lives in fear her condition causing internal decapitation. On Sunday 4th March, Ciara left for Barcelona, where she is under going life saving surgery. The cost of the surgery is €90,000 and will not be covered by the state. We are holding a Coffee Morning for Ciara in Raheen on Sunday 25th March after the 11 a.m. and 12.30 Masses in the Millennium Centre. All donations will be very much appreciated.
